APPROVAL of November 13, 2012 MINUTES:

PTG: None

Student Council: Noah Chun, our Student Council president, got permission from the State Ethics Committee to move ahead with their Big Brother Big Sister clothing drive. The event is scheduled for Feb. 24 – 28. Student Council will also be purchasing t-shirts for their officers and representatives.

Administration:

- The Financial Plan for the 2014 – 2015 school year has already been submitted which includes personnel. We don't expect to see a change in personnel next school year.
- Kindergarten Registration begins Feb. 3rd due to the age change next year. Students need to be 5 years of age on or before July 31st to enter Kindergarten. This change has been noted on our school webpage, via Twitter, on the parking lot marque, and in our Parent Bulletin.
- Facilities – we've seen an increase in use. KEWITT, Aiea/Pearl City Town hall meeting meets once a month. Hope Chapel Pearlview meets weekly and there is another church group that is interested in returning to our site.
- The State Ethics Commission has expressed a concern to DOE schools about fundraising for commercial companies. School activities involving The Foodbank (Canned Food Drive), Big Brother Big Sisters (Clothing Drive), and The American Heart Association (Jump Rope for Heart) have been approved by the commission

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Academic and Financial Plan - This year's process is different from previous years. The plan will be done through the Academic Review Team (ART), which is lead by Laura Brown.
 - The ART process involves 6 + 1 Priority Strategies which are overseen by different members of PRE's Support Team. The strategies include: Common Core State Standards (CCSS), Comprehensive Student Supports (CSS), Educator Effectiveness Systems (EES), Academic Review Teams (ART), Induction & Mentoring, Formative Instruction/Data Teams, and Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM)
 - The ART team is responsible with planning, doing, monitoring, and identifying next steps for school projects and initiatives written in our Academic and Financial Plan.
 - There will be an ART information meeting on January 31, 2014.
